Affairs Outpatient Care Center in Sepulveda,
California. The new Center is a model for the entire
VA system, offering a complete range of Outpatient
Diagnostic & Treatment Services in an innovative
"bed-less" hospital.

On a campus comprising new telecommunications and central plant facilities, the Center consolidates most patient services into a single, patient-friendly location supporting Primary Ambulatory Care (PACE) and Education Clinics, Specialty Clinics, 16 Operating Rooms Surgery Center, Imaging Center, Diagnostic Center and Ancillary Services.

Each of four PACE clinics offers the patient diverse medical specialties in a single environment, and each patient remains with one clinic permanently. Based on their success here, PACE clinics are spreading to other VA medical centers nationwide.
